All passengers sailing from a port of continental United States bound for a foreign port or a port of the insular possessions of the United States, or sailing from a port of said insular possessions bound for a foreign port, a port of continental United States, or a port of another insular possession, in whatsoever class they travel, must be fully listed or manifested according to the headings printed at top of columns and instructions printed on back hereof; and lists or manifests must be delivered to the immigration officials before departure by the master, commanding officer, or resident agent of any vessel having such passengers on board. This (pink) sheet is for first-cabin passengers only.
